Introduction

- There are many church people even spirit-filled with real bondages in their lives and preaching the Word alone hasn't released them into the freedom of God
- God has already provided for His people to be delivered and people desperately need help to be free. The role of Deliverance ministry is to connect people for a power encounter to be free. Deliverance is one of the ways the goodness of God is extended to us Ex 18:9 NKJV
- **Salvation and Deliverance**
- Salvation affords me eternal life (Heaven), Deliverance avails me Abundant life (here on Earth). Saying it differently:
- Jesus not only purchased the salvation of our soul, but His sufferings also secured our physical healing. In fact, **the word "salvation"** so frequently used in the New Testament, **comes from the Greek, SOTERIA, which means "wholeness and healing, both in the physical and spiritual."**

Theme Scripture: Exo 3:1-10; Matt 12:22-30

- Exo 3:1-10
- The Lord always needs a man through whom He can channel His strength to do His Pleasure on earth Ezek 22:31. He has chosen so. In the case of Israel, He chose Moses, a man rescued from water to rescue a nation.
- He almost always gives/brings a Revelation to the Deliverer or at the time of deliverance. The burning bush experience to draw the attention of His chosen vessels of deliverance. He burdens or unsettles them. Dan 9:1-3;
- The Lord see and hears the cries of His people, He is concerned. He even knows the cause of the Problem and Pain.
- It is His Will to Deliver His people out of a bad situation to a better one

Theme Cont'd:

- Mat 12:22-30
- Deliverance Ministry causes the wicked including the religious establishment to jealousy/envy and they will seek to Malign and explain it away. They will want to put the supernatural/divine intervention in their context, if it is not in their context, it doesn't add up and makes no sense. God will upset systems even His own natural laws for His glory (to harvest Praise Psa 65:1-5; Ezek 36:16-32; Isa 48:8-11; Jn 9);
- Deliverance is best carried out when there is agreement: with Word, God's conditions met; those to stand with you Mat 13:54-58; you either gather with Jesus or you are scattering away from Him
- Casting out devil is one of the manifestation of the kingdom of God

- 1Joh 3:7-8;
- 1Cor 15:19-26

Defining Deliverance

- To deliver is:
 - to rescue,
 - to draw out/away (Psa18:16),
 - to save,
 - to let/cause to escape (Psa 68:20), to redeem, to restore
- It is doing something about the problem
- A true witness delivereth souls (Pro 14:25a)
- But ye shall receive power, after that the Holy Ghost is come upon you: and ye shall be witnesses unto me both in Jerusalem, and in all Judaea, and in Samaria, and unto the uttermost part of the earth. Act 1:8
- Deliverance Ministry is True Witnessing for Christ unctioned by the Holy Spirit

Defining Deliverance

- Therefore the idea of Deliverance has to do with:
- i) Rescuing from bondage: Sin, Evil, death or judgment;
- ii) Process of Setting Satan's captives Free;
- iii) Liberating those under Satanic/demonic captivity Luk 4:18; Eph 4:8
- iv) Releasing those Restricted and Restrained by spirits of darkness especially, by the authority of the Word of God and the Name of Jesus Christ 2 Cor 10:4-5;
- v) Breaking Satanic Strongholds and Liberating those incarcerated therein. A stronghold is mindset that is impregnated with hopelessness that caused a person to accept as unchangeable, something in their lives even though it goes against the will of God (Melvin Maughmer Jr)

Hebrew understanding of Deliverance

(Dr Steve Ogan Understanding and Knowing what to do in 2014)

- 1. Natsal and Malat H5337 – this involves letting someone escape satanic domination. It means snatching out of danger; to take away;
- 2. Rhoumai – rescuing and drawing someone to one's side. The intention is to have fellowship with the delivered one. Ex 18:8-11;
- 3. Yasha – this involves creating ample space between the delivered person and their enemies (Ex 14:19); ensuring that the enemy is beaten back (Psa 44:5) and brought into subjection so that they do not harass (Gen 49:23-24) the endangered person and ensuring that the person delivered is brought into a spacious, ample broad place (Psa 18:19; 31:8b) Pray Ex 13:14-15

God Wants you Delivered

- And the LORD said, I have surely seen the affliction of my people which *are* in Egypt, and have heard their cry by reason of their taskmasters; for I know their sorrows; And I am come down to deliver them out of the hand of the Egyptians, and to bring them up out of that land unto a good land and a large, unto a land flowing with milk and honey; unto the place of the Canaanites, and the Hittites, and the Amorites, and the Perizzites, and the Hivites, and the Jebusites. Now therefore, behold, the cry of the children of Israel is come unto me: and I have also seen the oppression wherewith the Egyptians oppress them. Come now therefore, and I will send thee unto Pharaoh, that thou mayest bring forth my people the children of Israel out of Egypt. Ex 3:7-10
- But upon mount Zion shall be deliverance, and there shall be holiness; and the house of Jacob shall possess their possessions. **Oba 1:17**
 - Deliverance
 - Holiness
 - Possession

God Wants you Delivered

- That he would grant unto us, that we being delivered out of the hand of our enemies might serve him without fear, In holiness and righteousness before him, all the days of our life. Luk 1:74-75
- Deliverance sets us free to serve God well and this include:
 - Serving Him without Fear (Psa 64:1; 2 Tim 1:7);
 - Serving Him in Holiness& Righteousness (Psa 19:12-13)
 - Serving Him all the Days of our life (Deut 12:1; Mat 24:13; 1 Pet 1:9)
- The Spirit of the Lord *is* upon me, because he hath anointed me to preach the gospel to the poor; he hath sent me to heal the brokenhearted, to preach deliverance to the captives, and recovering of sight to the blind, to set at liberty them that are bruised Luk 4:18

God Wants you Delivered

- O wretched man that I am! Who shall deliver me from the body of this death? I thank God through Jesus Christ our Lord. So then with the mind I myself serve the law of God; but with the flesh the law of sin. Rom 7:24-25
- Thank God! Jesus Christ will rescue me. So with my mind I serve the Law of God, although my selfish desires make me serve the law of sin v25 (CEV) .
- Apostle Paul longed for Deliverance, why not you?

How to Tell You Need Deliverance

- Scaring dreams and nightmares.
- Inherited chronic sickness in the family line.
- A disturbing incurable, painful chest pains.
- Movement of things in your body.
- Feeling of weight being carried on your body.
- Restlessness on the inside.
- A vehement opposition to deliverance.
- Struggling to read the Bible and to pray.
- Excessive anger.
- Unforgiveness and bitterness.
- Rejection.
- Sexual lust.
- Rebellion.

In Need of Deliverance Cont'd:

- Insecurity in one's life.
- Barrenness and miscarriage.
- Suicide thoughts and tendencies.
- Bed wetting even as an adult – a rare condition.
- Feeling like there is another person living inside of you making decisions for you.
- Ability to hear sounds – footsteps or noises that others around you cannot hear.
- Painful or irregular monthly periods.
- Getting choked while worshipping God and feeling of resistance on the inside.
- Violent mood swings.
- Wanting a lot of attention from other people (Approval).
- Flashes of blasphemous thoughts.
- Torment of fear.
- Inability to overcome particular sins.
- Discomfort when listening to teachings on demonic deliverance.
- Insomnia.
