# THE PROVOST'S MESSAGE!

# **EXHIBITION OF CHRISTIAN MATURITY (EPHESIANS 4:1-13)**

**Maturity** is the process of becoming an adult. It is also related to gaining independence from parents in some aspects of life. Spiritual Maturity is important, God expects us to grow from one level of our relationship with Christ to another. After evangelism then discipleship is key. Any parent will feel disturbed if a child stagnates.

After our mission week encounters then feeding on and digesting the word of God is needed. The writers of the Bible percieve immature Christians as **infants who cannot eat solid food**. They are described as **people tossed here and there** by waves and carried about by every wind of doctrine, by the trickery of men, by craftiness in deceitful scheming. However God calls every believer to grow in the faith by speaking the truth in love in all aspects, into Him who is the head, even Christ. In our Churches God intends us to focus on discipleship aspects like Bible study, Sunday school, and other small, accountability groups like cell ministry. This will create avenues of consistent growth in Christ.

Ephesians 4:1-7 gives us a glimpse of Our maturity in Christ. A mature Christian **will live as a prisoner of Christ.** He or she will run away from sin. He or she will Be humble and Gentle, patient and bear with others in love, keeping the unity of the Sprit and have peace. Maturity in christ will help us to be united as believers.

As a prisoner for the Lord, then, I urge you to live a life worthy of the calling you have received. 2 Be completely humble and gentle; be patient, bearing with one another in love. 3 Make every effort to keep the unity of the Spirit through the bond of peace. 4 There is one body and one Spirit, just as you were called to one hope when you were called; 5 one Lord, one faith, one baptism; 6 one God and Father of all, who is over all and through all and in all.

7 But to each one of us grace has been given as Christ apportioned it. 8 This is why it[a] says:

"When he ascended on high,

he took many captives

and gave gifts to his people."[b]

God intends us to grow so that we can **operate in the calling of God** upon each of our lives and serve in the body of Christ. Ephesians 4:11-13. We are to equip the saints for ministry" and "to [build] up the body of Christ.

11 So Christ himself gave the apostles, the prophets, the evangelists, the pastors and teachers, 12 to equip his people for works of service, so that the body of Christ may be built up 13 until we all reach unity in the faith and in the knowledge of the Son of God and become mature, attaining to the whole measure of the fullness of Christ.
