#### ACP UPDATE FOR SUNDAY 10TH AUGUST, 2025

Phase 4 -The Final Completion Phase is now here. His Grace, the Archbishop and Bishop of the Diocese of Kampala signed the Contracts for the Completion Works and Installations on 30th June 2025. The two Contractors engaged will work concurrently starting July 2025. These are:

- AluClad Limited Specialist Contractor for Exteriors Cladding and Stained Glazed Windows
- Costa Construction Services Ltd General Building Contractor who will do the Offices, Lifts, Bell Tower, Signages and MEP Installations.

Given that the Cathedral site is now occupied, the on-coming works will be carefully scheduled to minimize church ministry operations. However, some inevitable inconvenience due to construction site activities may be experienced. Kindly bear with the discomfort for a little while as we strive to achieve the best for God's house which deserves to be finished well.

Brethren, we thank you all for persistent Prayers, Participation, Provision and mobilizing Partners for this great work as we whole heartedly serve our God in our generation. Let us continue running this race till it is fully done. Let us enjoy our new Cathedral!

#### B. Technical Status

#### 1. Defects Liability Period for Retiring Contracts (Phase 3)

- After the new Cathedral was consecrated and opened for Worship on 01st November 2024
  in usable state, the retiring contractors for Interior works have been serving the defects
  liability period while monitoring any construction defects to be rectified. We are in the
  final stages of signing-off the final admeasured works done for payment of balances and
  the contracts will be closed.
- 2. Phase 4 Completion Works
- The planned construction period is 15 months commencing July 2025. The planned completion timeline is therefore October 2026.
- The Exterior wall finishing will be high grade non-combustible (A1 fire-rated) Aluminum
  Composite cladding fixed on light aluminum framing with superior ultra-violet properties
  to minimize fading. This material selection is intended to give a low maintenance cost,
  self-cleaning and quality aesthetics suitable for this iconic Cathedral.

The Stained Glass Windows will be Laminated Tempered glass with Digital Printing design patterns infused within the heavy-duty glazing.

- The Completion Building Works will involve the new Cathedral Offices at Lower ground level, 2no. Lifts, Bell Tower partitioning and finishes, Signages, Air-conditioning for closed rooms which have minimal access to external natural environment, MEP and other services installations.
- Even if we achieved partial completion and occupation, the project is still in the hands
  of Supervising Consultants and Contractors for works-in-progress in various areas. Let us
  support them for the good of our own project.

#### THE PROVOST'S MESSAGE!!!

## CHRIST THE SOURCE OF NEWNESS! (REV 21:1-5)

Christ came into this world to change the destiny of humanity. To renew the hearts of men and women drawing them from the dungeon of sin to the eternal bliss in glory. Christ offers eternal life to all who yield to him in sincerity, truth and honesty. Those who open their hearts and confess that Jesus is Lord, he receives them and gives them new life. The New life Christ offers is what he promised in John 10:10, it is abundant life; the life that changes a sinner into a saint. This month our call is for believers to embrace the hope we have for eternal life and for non-believers to realize that life is only found in Jesus Christ.

It is this hope that will enable us to enter the **New world declared in Revelation 21**. In this new life is a gift to every believer and is mentioned as a new Jerusalem, a holy city coming down from heaven like a bride. The world and all that is in it will pass away. All we have acquired in this life will be taken away when we finally transition into the new world. The reality of us **being the temple of the Lord will manifest when God fully dwells in our hearts.** He will be our God and we shall be his people. This new tabernacle is a reflection of what God said in **Levitucus 10** You shall eat the old harvest, and clear out the old because of the new. I will set My tabernacle among you, and My soul shall not abhor you. I will walk among you and be your God, and you shall be My people. I am the LORD your God, who brought you out of the land of Egypt, that you should not be their slaves; I have broken the bands of your yoke and made you walk upright.

This was a time of Jubilee when the children of Israel were to enjoy the new fruit, the yoke was broken, they were set free, the slaves were released. The Lord pledged to be with them as in 2 Corinthians 6:16. 16 And what agreement has the temple of God with idols? For you are the temple of the living God. As God has said: "I will dwell in them And walk among them. I will be their God, And they shall be My people."

God chooses people in seasons and isolates them to be his, no other person can heal the soul except Jesus. The new life in Christ has no part in idolatry and hence Paul calls believers not to have any association with idolatry in 2 Corinthians 6:17-18. (Rev 21:4).
