THE PROVOST'S MESSAGE!

SUMMARY OF NOVEMBER 2024 MISSION WEEK MESSAGES

The Chief Missioner, The Most Rev. Benjamin Kwashi has been preaching.

1. The Power Of Witnessing [Acts 14:1-3]-Theme exposition]-witnessing brings the demonstration of God's power through the ordinary human being. The Gospel is powerful it can enter any heart. In witnessing the Gospel transforms peoples lives. It is a call to repentance.

2. Being Firm in Witnessing [Acts 4:13-20]-God gives us courage to witness for His glory not for our pride. We therefore need a good devotional life. Apostle Peter devoted himself to the word and prayer. Witnessing is possible in families as people hear the stories of Jesus Christ.

3. The Power of Oneness in Witnessing [Acts 4:32-37]-God calls us to be united to witness. God's Love can unite people of different cultures. Salvation is only in Christ. The disciples lived in fellowship in the early church. Barnabas sold a field and supported ministry.

4. The Call to Witnessing [Mark. 3:13-20]-A Clergy Session

5. Witnesses as God's Workmanship [Eph. 2:1-10]-Each one of us should be a witness of God and God's workmanship for eternity. Even if you are a minority it is an opportunity to cry to God. You cannot escape hell and death outside Christ; you need to be in Christ all the time, now adopted child of God. A branch of the vine saved by Christ. God is looking for labourers.

5. The Role of Signs & Wonders in Witnessing [John 12:12-19]-A primary witness who has experienced Christ for himself can convince people about Christ and affirm His power through the Gospel. Jesus effectively witnessed as through one method especially in calling the disciples. Signs and wonders can make people accept Christ.

6. The Power of Prayer in Witnessing [Col. 4:2-5]-The preacher encouraged us to persevere in prayer. He said that prayer must be inside of you and you must be in prayer all the time. We need to pray for our children continuously. We need to be sober in prayer and do away with anger, bitterness and jealousy, unforgiveness for effective witness.

7. The Grace to Witness [1 Pet. 3:13-17] -A ministers session

8. The Role of the Holy Spirit in Witnessing [Acts. 1:1-8]-The Holy Spirit gives us the power to preach.
