ACP UPDATE FOR SUNDAY 15TH JUNE, 2025.

After the new Cathedral was consecrated and opened for Worship on 01st November 2024 in usable state, it became necessary to wind down the running contracts for Interior works within 6 months while monitoring any construction defects to be rectified.

Given that the Cathedral site is now occupied, the pending works will have to be carefully scheduled to minimize church ministry operations. Due-diligence and pre-contracting engagements for exterior Cladding Works to Slanting Walls and bell tower are on-going and this new contract is expected to commence in July 2025 while pending offices (on lower ground) and installations for functionality, will be done in a staggered approach.

Brethren, we thank you all for persistent Prayers, Participation, Provision and mobilizing Partners for this great work to see this momentous achievement in our generation. Let us continue running this race till it is fully done. Let us enjoy our new Cathedral!

Financial Status

The final lap to full completion of the new Cathedral is estimated as follows:

- Exterior Wall Cladding = UGX 5 Billion
- Cathedral Offices and Installations = 1.7 Billion
- Lifts - 2no. = UGX 0.8 Billion
- Total Estimate = UGX 7.5 Billion

Technical Status

Even if we achieved partial completion and occupation, the project is still in the hands of Supervising Consultants and Contractors for works-in-progress in various areas.

- The improvement of the basement parking ambience with decent finishes on the floors, walls, ceiling and lighting is completed. This provides a clean and user-friendly environment.
- Fire-fighting installations are completed, tested and commissioned
- The Exterior wall finishing will be high grade cladding fixed on light aluminum framing with superior ultra-violet properties to minimize fading. This material selection is intended to give a low maintenance cost, *self-cleaning* and quality aesthetics suitable for this iconic Cathedral. Pre-contract activities are nearly complete and the contract for Exterior Cladding Works is expected to commence in July 2025.
- The Completion Building Works for Cathedral Offices at Lower ground level and other services installations are also under pre-contracting review.

THE PROVOST'S MESSAGE!!!

TOPIC: TRINITY: THE BASIS FOR OUR UNITY (ROMANS 5:1-5, JOHN 17:1-21)

Although Jesus did not mention the word Trinity in His prayer in John 17, The mutual indwelling and love between the Father and the Son, as described in Jesus' prayer, are considered foundational to the doctrine of the Trinity. Jesus describes his oneness with the father as very key for the believers and for the future of the church. I do not pray for these alone but also for those who will believe in me through their word; that they all may be one, as you father are in me and I in you. That they may also be one in us that the world may believe that you sent me" (John 17:20-21).

John Piper rightly says; The unity of the church does not threaten doctrine; the unity of the church is a doctrine. The Bible teaches, clearly and emphatically, "There is one body and one Spirit, one Lord, one faith, one baptism, one God and Father of all, who is over all and through all and in all" (Ephesians 4:4-6). Our unity bears witness to the gospel, because our unity is part of the gospel. Are we as doctrinally pure as we claim to be?

Paul made an appeal to the Corinthians; I appeal to you, brothers, by the name of our Lord Jesus Christ, that all of you agree and that there be no divisions among you, but that you be united in the same mind and the same judgment (1 Corinthians 1:10). Christians today are totally divided in faith, thoughts and it is visible in every congregation. Paul once again says "Aim for restoration, comfort one another, agree with one another, live in peace, and the God of love and peace will be with you (2 Corinthians 13:11). The same unity is mentioned to the Christians in Philippi; "Only let your manner of life be worthy of the gospel of Christ, so that whether I come and see you or am absent, I may hear of you that you are standing firm in one spirit, with one mind, striving side by side for the faith of the gospel" (Philippians 1:27).

Unity in the church produces the fruit of the Holy Spirit which is Joy. Paul said; "Complete my joy by being of the same mind, having the same love, being in full accord and of one mind (Philippians 2:2). Jesus makes it more critical when he warns people against giving gifts out of an impure heart. If you are offering your gift at the altar and there remember that your brother has something against you, leave your gift there before the altar and go. First be reconciled to your brother, and then come and offer your gift (Matthew 5:23-24). Jesus' prayer in John 17 was that the church he was going to die for will remain united. Christ will come back to take the bride not brides. The bride is one solid church firmly rooted on the foundation of Jesus Christ who alone is our redeemer and the rock of our salvation. On this Trinity Sunday my singular prayer is that the body of Christ will be united. Unity is possible when we know Jesus Christ as Lord and savior who shed blood and purchased every soul.
