## THE PROVOST'S MESSAGE!

## BE HOLY BECAUSE I AM HOLY [1 PETER 1:13-25]

The Holiness of God refers to the greatness of God's incomparable being and His blameless, faultless, unblemished moral purity (Isaiah 6:1-5; Revelation 4:1-8). The absolute moral purity of God's character. Holiness- refers to something or someone that has been separated from the common or set aside for God's use.

Holiness is the absolute moral purity of God's character that sets Him apart, making Him different from every other living creature. Yet He calls His people to be holy as He is holy.

Sometimes we human beings tend to fear God and try to be far from Him because we feel we cannot measure up to His standards of purity and blamelessness. Genesis 1:27 and 100: 3. We give God all the reverence but at the same time examine our lives in the light of his uprightness. Isaiah 6:1-5 as God called Isaiah to ministry he cleansed him, in the vision he saw angels affirmed that Holy, Holy is the Lord. The Prophet Daniel in Daniel 8:17 and Apostle John in Revelation 1:17 had a mixture of attraction and fear towards our God also Revelation 15:2:2-4.
