ACP UPDATE FOR SUNDAY 22ND JUNE, 2025

After the new Cathedral was consecrated and opened for Worship on 01st November 2024 in usable state, it became necessary to wind down the running contracts for Interior works within 6 months while monitoring any construction defects to be rectified.

Given that the Cathedral site is now occupied, the pending works will have to be carefully scheduled to minimize church ministry operations. Due-diligence and pre-contracting engagements for exterior Cladding Works to Slanting Walls and bell tower are on-going and this new contract is expected to commence in July 2025 while pending offices (on lower ground) and installations for functionality, will be done in a staggered approach.

Brethren, we thank you all for persistent Prayers, Participation, Provision and mobilizing Partners for this great work to see this momentous achievement in our generation. Let us continue running this race till it is fully done. Let us enjoy our new Cathedral!

Financial Status

The final lap to full completion of the new Cathedral is estimated as follows:

- Exterior Wall Cladding = UGX 5 Billion
- Cathedral Offices and Installations = 1.7 Billion
- Lifts 2no. = UGX 0.8 Billion
- Total Estimate = UGX 7.5 Billion

Technical Status

Even if we achieved partial completion and occupation, the project is still in the hands of Supervising Consultants and Contractors for works-in-progress in various areas.

- The improvement of the basement parking ambience with decent finishes on the floors, walls, ceiling and lighting is completed. This provides a clean and user-friendly environment.
- Fire-fighting installations are completed, tested and commissioned
- The Exterior wall finishing will be high grade cladding fixed on light aluminum framing with superior ultra-violet properties to minimize fading. This material selection is intended to give a low maintenance cost, self-cleaning and quality aesthetics suitable for this iconic Cathedral. Pre-contract activities are nearly complete and the contract for Exterior Cladding Works is expected to commence in July 2025.
- The Completion Building Works for Cathedral Offices at Lower ground level and other services installations are also under pre-contracting review.

THE PROVOST'S MESSAGE!!!

BEING LED BY THE HOLY SPIRIT!

Alot has been explained about the Holy Spirit this month. As we come to the close of this series of teachings today, it is important to realise that we need the leadership of the Holy Spirit. The Holy Spirit is a helper that each one of us recieves after welcoming Christ in each of our hearts. The Holy Spirit permanently indwells believers (John 14:26). Being led by the Spirit means to be prompted, instructed, or directed by the Holy Spirit. In Matthew 4:1 we see an example of Jesus being led by the Spirit into the wilderness. Jesus Christ was God but he never relied on his own ability but on Gods power. When we recieve the Holy Spirit after our confession of Christ as Lord and saviour, He starts to guide us. With the guidance of the Holy Spirit Our identity is then made sure in Him, we get the assurance of salvation as children of God. We are not just His people in General but God's Children. (Romans 8:14)

Some Characteristics of being led by the Spirit

- The Holy Spirit will lead us in alignment to the will of God. He will allow you and I to do
 things within the limits of Gods word. The Holy Spirit will always glorify Jesus through
 you and I.
- He will not allow us to do something that does not glorify God, for example watching demonic tv programs. You will feel a conviction that will make you stop.

Some of the benefits of being led by the Spirit include:-

- 1. Freedom from the Curse of the Law(Ephesians 5:18)-When the Holy Spirit leads we are not going to struggle to please God on our own this power of God will make it natural and our salvation will not be just a religious venture but a spiritual one
- 2. Decision Making- This life has a puzzles and dilemmas but when you pray over a number of issues the Holy Spirit will help you make good decisions.
- 3. Confidence in our relationship with God and our eternal home in heaven.

4. A victorious life here on earth that will lead to our glorification to heaven. Chains are brocken, spiritual blindness and generational curses are brocken.

How to be sure you are being led by the Spirit and not feelings or imagainations?

It is very good to walk with God and understand the leading of Gods Spirit. 1 John 4:1-4 calls upon us to test every Spirit so that we do not get into contradictions of false leaders who are not in one accord with Christ. You need to grow in God to this level but still handle issues around this with Godily wisdom and love.

Conclusion

If you desire the direction of the Holy Spirit please accept Christ as Lord and saviour, read the Bible pray daily, fellowship and desire the fresh fire of the Holy Spirt to fill you daily.
