ACP UPDATE FOR SUNDAYS - NOVEMBER/ DECEMBER, 2024

Finally, the new Cathedral was consecrated and opened for Worship on 01st November 2024. The new Sanctuary reached usable state and partial occupation was attained upon practical completion of the Interiors. The regulator granted Partial Occupation Permit prior to the consecration events.

As can be expected for any new building, we shall continue to improve what is not working out well under the building works and installations done so far while the Cathedral Management handles furnishing, audio-visual equipment, ICT and Security installations and other operational aspects for the Sanctuary.

Given that the Cathedral site is now occupied, the pending works will have to be carefully scheduled to minimize church ministry operations. Exterior Cladding Works to Slanting Walls and bell tower will commence in February 2025 while pending offices (on lower ground) and installations for functionality, will be done in a staggered approach.

Brethren, we thank you all for persistent Prayers, Participation, Provision and mobilizing Partners for this great work to see this momentous achievement in our generation. Let us continue running this race till it is fully done. Let us enjoy our new Cathedral!

Financial Status

We praise God that the funding gap on the Interior works was closed to cover the Interiors excluding inevitable variations encountered. The final lap to full completion of the new Cathedral expected to commence in February 2025 is estimated as follows:

- Exterior Wall Cladding = UGX 5 Billion
- Cathedral Offices and Installations = 1.7 Billion
- Lifts - 2no. = UGX 0.8 Billion
- Total Estimate = UGX 7.5 Billion

Technical Status

Even if we have achieved partial completion and occupation, the project is still in the hands of Supervising Consultants and Contractors for works-in-progress in various areas.

- Currently, the Basements are being improved with terrazzo floor finishes and painting to provide a clean and user-friendly environment. The finishes to basement parking together with fire-fighting systems, plumbing and drainage works are expected to be completed by end of January 2025.
- Power Supply and back-up Generator - including a transformer on main grid were installed.
- The Exterior wall finishing will be high grade cladding fixed on light aluminum framing with superior ultra-violet properties to minimize fading. This material selection is intended to give a low maintenance cost, self-cleansing and quality aesthetics suitable for this iconic Cathedral. The Exterior Cladding Works will commence in February 2025.

THE PROVOST'S MESSAGE!

FINISHING WELL (1 SAMUEL 18:20-35,)

We are grateful to God who has enabled us meet on this family Sunday as we focus on 'Finishing well'. God expects us to be careful and organized in every assignment given to us. We are to start well and have a good end. Situations might get hard in the process but the Lord wants us to develop an attitude of wisdom and perseverance. He also expects us to leave vengeance with him.

Our texts today reveal the need to ***operate in Love and leave vengeance to God in relation to our duties***. King soul wanted to Kill David but David never tried to kill him even when he got an opportunity to do so. The Gospel is a calling towards us to love the enemies and even pray for them. Our motives and actions should not be directed towards hurting or destroying others but they should be focused on loving people the way God would. It is good to know that there are those difficult people around us but God expects us to do our part and leave him to handle the rest.

Finishing well also is linked to ***the Grace of God and consistency in our assignments***. We are all expected to keep track of our achievements and pending areas prayerfully. This is a trick that is going to help us to do our duties in an excellent way.
