THE PROVOST'S MESSAGE!

TOPIC: THE BENEFITS OF GIVING (PROVERBS 19:17)

This whole month our meditation has been on giving. Today we get to the end of this series by looking at the benefit of giving as follows:

Giving reveals our Obedience to God (Deuteronomy 14:22-23)-The concept of tithing, as described in Deuteronomy, goes beyond simply giving money. It's a demonstration of obedience and trust in God's provision.

Giving Sets Priorities Straight (Matthew 6:21)-Jesus' words in Matthew 6:21 remind us that where we invest our resources reveals what truly matters to us.

Giving increases the Faith (2 Corinthians 9:6)-The scripture in 2 Corinthians 9:6 teaches that giving is an act of faith and helps us to have apositive attitude as we do that.

Giving Acknowledges God's Ownership of our resources (1 Chronicles 29:14)-Everything we have belongs to God and so we should be good stewards and give thanks to Him.

Giving Leads to Joy (Acts 20:35)-True joy comes from giving, not just receiving.

Giving reveals Compassion and Involvement (James 2:14-17)- The giver connects through empathy and sympathy with the needs of others and fostering compassion.

Giving shows the Evidence of Our Love (1 John 3:17-18)-The Bible teaches that true love is not just about feelings; it's about what we do. 1 John

Giving releases us from Greed (Proverbs 11:24-25)-We are saved from wanting everything for our individual benefit. Greed is a destructive desire.

Giving helps us to invest in eternity (Matthew 6:20)-Our earthly possessions are temporary, but the rewards of giving can last forever. These are the treasures stored in Heaven.

Giving attracts God's Blessings (Proverbs 22:9)-The Bible promises blessings of successful life and Prosperity and Refreshing to those who give.

Makes Room for More Blessings (Malachi 3:10-12)-Malachi 3:10-12 presents a powerful image of God's generosity in response to our giving: Breaking Through Scarcity.

- **12. Debt-Free Living (Proverbs 22:7)**-While not directly tied to giving, some interpretations of scripture suggest a connection between generosity and financial freedom. Proverbs 22:7
- **13. Feeling Lighter without burdens (Proverbs 11:24-25)**-The proverb explored earlier (Proverbs 11:24-25) about the generous person who prospers.
