## ACP UPDATE FOR SUNDAY 29TH JUNE, 2025

After the new Cathedral was consecrated and opened for Worship on 01st November 2024 in usable state, it became necessary to wind down the running contracts for Interior works within 6 months while monitoring any construction defects to be rectified.

Given that the Cathedral site is now occupied, the pending works will have to be carefully scheduled to minimize church ministry operations. Due-diligence and pre-contracting engagements for exterior Cladding Works to Slanting Walls and bell tower are on-going and this new contract is expected to commence in July 2025 while pending offices (on lower ground) and installations for functionality, will be done in a staggered approach.

Brethren, we thank you all for persistent Prayers, Participation, Provision and mobilizing Partners for this great work to see this momentous achievement in our generation. Let us continue running this race till it is fully done. Let us enjoy our new Cathedral!

### Financial Status

The final lap to full completion of the new Cathedral is estimated as follows:

- Exterior Wall Cladding = UGX 5 Billion
- Cathedral Offices and Installations = 1.7 Billion
- Lifts 2no. = UGX 0.8 Billion
- Total Estimate = UGX 7.5 Billion

Even if we achieved partial completion and occupation, the project is still in the hands of Supervising Consultants and Contractors for works-in-progress in various areas.

- The improvement of the basement parking ambience with decent finishes on the floors, walls, ceiling and lighting is completed. This provides a clean and user-friendly environment.
- Fire-fighting installations are completed, tested and commissioned
- The Exterior wall finishing will be high grade cladding fixed on light aluminum framing with superior ultra-violet properties to minimize fading. This material selection is intended to give a low maintenance cost, self-cleaning and quality aesthetics suitable for this iconic Cathedral. Pre-contract activities are nearly complete and the contract for Exterior Cladding Works is expected to commence in July 2025.
- The Completion Building Works for Cathedral Offices at Lower ground level and other services installations are also under pre-contracting review.

# THE PROVOST'S MESSAGE!!!

### REFLECTION ON THE ORIGIN OF ST. PETERS DAY

Some Bible Scholars agree that St. Peter's Day celebrates the life and mission of Saint Peter, one of Jesus' closest followers and the first leader of the Church. Many Christians around the world mark this day with special worship services to honor his courage, dedication, and role in guiding the early Church. People remember his transformation from a humble fisherman to a bold leader entrusted with carrying forward the faith. This celebration weaves together a deep sense of unity and respect across different Christian communities.

Communities bring the story to life in joyful ways. Some gather at coastal towns where fishermen pray for protection at sea. In Rome, the day features grand ceremonies led by the Pope. He blesses the faithful, honors new archbishops, and emphasizes mission and service. The mood is vibrant. People feel a shared bond, inspired by Peter's journey of faith, his courage to speak out, and his powerful example of leadership. Saint Peter's special day began long ago in early Christian Rome. The community first observed it to honor Peter's martyrdom in the city, believed to have happened between AD 64 and 68 under Nero's rule. Leaders chose the date tied to the anniversary of his death or when his relics were moved. That day later became a yearly feast for both Peter and Paul. The Pope and bishops officially added the feast to church calendars very early. Church records show celebrations in the fourth century and perhaps before.

Over time, the feast spread across Catholic, Eastern Orthodox, Anglican, and Lutheran traditions. Today, their joint feast remains one of the Church's most important commemorations. In short, this feast started in the first few centuries of Christianity. Rome's community first honored Peter's faithful witness. Church leaders then made the celebration official. It honors Peter as one of the first leaders of the Church and as a bold friend of Jesus.

# Relevance of this Reflection to Christian Families Today?

With the help of our main text, 1 John 4:1-6, we pray that our Fathers will uphold values of Chrisitanity, salvation and family by detecting the different spirits that influence Christian Life. Peter was very stable later in His faith in Christ but we know that he was not the very fine in Christ at some point. He rejected Christ three times and he later repented when the cock crawed, as Jesus was being persecuted he cut the ear of Malchus but during the day of pentecost we see Him explaining Christs salvation and defends the coming and the promise of the promise and actions of the Holy Spirit in Acts 2. He completes his life as a Faithful Mytyr of Christ.

Our text calls upon us to discern and not accept every Spirit. Fathers are to check the Spirits operating around them at home, work and individual lives and only embrace the values and actions of the Holy Spirit. Fathers are to welcome Christ as Lord and Saviour, like Peter who confessed that Jesus is the Christ in Matthew 16:13-20. When salvation is embraced then spirits of greed, lust, idolatry, adultery, confusion in families and violence among other voices will end. Fathers by recieving Christ and the Holy Sprit will please our God the father and become good leaders who will take the Family, Church and the Nation in the right direction. Without Christ we cannot have good Fathers or Husbands. Men need Christ.
