ACP UPDATE FOR SUNDAY 3RD AUGUST, 2025

Phase 4 -The Final Completion Phase is now here. His Grace, the Archbishop and Bishop of the Diocese of Kampala signed the Contracts for the Completion Works and Installations on 30th June 2025. The two Contractors engaged will work concurrently starting July 2025. These are:

- AluClad Limited - Specialist Contractor for Exteriors Cladding and Stained Glazed Windows
- Costa Construction Services Ltd - General Building Contractor who will do the Offices, Lifts, Bell Tower, Signages and MEP Installations.

Given that the Cathedral site is now occupied, the on-coming works will be carefully scheduled to minimize church ministry operations. However, some inevitable inconvenience due to construction site activities may be experienced. Kindly bear with the discomfort for a little while as we strive to achieve the best for God's house which deserves to be finished well.

Brethren, we thank you all for persistent Prayers, Participation, Provision and mobilizing Partners for this great work as we whole heartedly serve our God in our generation. Let us continue running this race till it is fully done. Let us enjoy our new Cathedral!

B. Technical Status

1. Defects Liability Period for Retiring Contracts (Phase 3)

- After the new Cathedral was consecrated and opened for Worship on 01st November 2024 in usable state, the retiring contractors for Interior works have been serving the defects liability period while monitoring any construction defects to be rectified. We are in the final stages of signing-off the final admeasured works done for payment of balances and the contracts will be closed.

2. Phase 4 Completion Works

- The planned construction period is 15 months commencing July 2025. The planned completion timeline is therefore October 2026.
- The Exterior wall finishing will be high grade non-combustible (A1 fire-rated) Aluminum Composite cladding fixed on light aluminum framing with superior ultra-violet properties to minimize fading. This material selection is intended to give a low maintenance cost, self-cleaning and quality aesthetics suitable for this iconic Cathedral.

The Stained Glass Windows will be Laminated Tempered glass with Digital Printing design patterns infused within the heavy-duty glazing.

- The Completion Building Works will involve the new Cathedral Offices at Lower ground level, 2no. Lifts, Bell Tower partitioning and finishes, Signages, Air-conditioning for closed rooms which have minimal access to external natural environment, MEP and other services installations.
- Even if we achieved partial completion and occupation, the project is still in the hands of Supervising Consultants and Contractors for works-in-progress in various areas. Let us support them for the good of our own project.

THE PROVOST'S MESSAGE!!!

RENEWED FOR SERVICE EPHESIANS 4:17-24, LUKE 8:1-3

Today we celebrate a woman called Mary Magdalene whom Jesus healed and she immediately started serving and attending to his needs. Today is also a day we start our Men's Prayer conference. In all functions that might not seem related, the common fact is service. Both men and women need to be rejuvenated to serve the Lord through prayer and preaching of the gospel.

In **Luke 8:1-3**, as Jesus moved in villages preaching the gospel together with his twelve disciples, Mary Magdalene is specifically highlighted as one woman who had been delivered from 7 demons. The other women named had been healed of evil spirits and infirmities. These women recognized the work that Jesus had done in their lives, the love he had for them as women, their communion with him for continuous learning and service.

In **Ephesians 4:22-24**, Paul calls the Christians to put off the old self, which they had acquired from the flesh, the old life style before Christ and be renewed in their minds. His call for renewal demands that they put on a new self-created after the likeness of God in true righteousness and holiness. It is until individuals offload or put off the old nature and allow Christ to be fully manifested in them that **they can be able to serve the Lord with honesty and integrity**. Men who are going to be part of the prayer conference and women who are being enrolled today are being ushered in service for the Lord.

To serve the Lord better one has to recognize and appreciate the **saving grace of God**. Mary and the other women appreciated Jesus for accepting them the way they were and changing their lives for better. Like David in **Psalms 116:12-14** there is nothing an individual will ever pay God for his faithfulness except to serve him. David committed that he will pay his vows to the Lord in the presence of all his people. He was determined to testify about what the Lord had done in his life. **Serving the Lord requires a renewed mindset**. Some people change in words but continue living as if nothing happened. Character is very difficult to deal with. Paul in **Ephesians 4:25-32** narrates the evidence of a renewed life. **A renewed person must never associate with wickedness at all**. They are to be kind, tender hearted, forgiving one another just as Christ forgave us.

To risk their lives for the gospel. Mary went to the grave to look for Jesus at a moment when nobody was willing to accompany her. That is where we get the theme "**I have seen the Lord**" (**John 20:18**). To see the Lord has become a daily experience where people have to go out of their way and experience Jesus. The woman with the flow of blood risked being beaten by the crowd in order to touch Jesus. Some of us are helped by the glory around us, others want to be silent Christians, others want to be Christians when conditions are favourable. Christianity is a journey of those who are bold and totally sold out for Christ. May God bless you as you walk through your individual journey of renewal. Step out of your comfort zone and serve the Lord.
