**ACP UPDATE FOR SUNDAY**

**7<sup>TH</sup> AUGUST, 2022**



The ACP Team is grateful to God for His faithfulness for the Cathedral Building project. We continue to execute works (in Lots) under Phase 3 despite the challenges that arose from the COVID-19 Pandemic and slow recovery of the sector. The new Sanctuary is fully plastered internally and external works for storm water drainage, paving, boundary fencing and gates were done. Thank you, for your continued support.

Project completion for all works and installations is anticipated within one and half years. However, in preparation to host the Kampala Diocese 50th Anniversary celebrations in August this year, the ACP team together with the Cathedral leadership, the Consultants and Contractors are working to ensure that the site will be in usable state to host the events as desired with the help of God. Brethren, the finishing line is near, do not despair! We encourage you to continue to: Pray, Participate, Provide and (mobilize) Partners for this great work as we honour God.

**B. Technical Status**

Effective April 2022, the project Consultants were re-engaged in line with the statutory requirements under the Building Control Regulations. The pending mortgage settlement and ownership challenges for Plot 4 Lugard road have delayed the acquisition of the Building Permit required from KCCA in order for full scale site operations.

Due to interfaces and overlaps in works and installations for the various Lots, a single procurement cycle for all pending scope will be initiated after August 2022. Currently, the following works are on-going:

- Lot 5A - Public Washrooms (re-located) and Selected offices on Lower Ground
- Lot 6A - Floor Finishes in Terrazzo (for high traffic and wet areas)
- Lot 8A - Windows to Vertical Walls - samples approved and mass fabrication in progress
- Lot 9 - Acoustic Ceiling - under procurement (samples were provided while tender documentation and solicitation are in progress)

**“Kola Wotuula” Ceiling Works Campaign”.**

The Kolo Wotuula Ceiling Campaign commenced in March 2022 and is intended to organize us in smaller units to raise 1,000 individuals/families/fellowships/home cells each contributing at least Ugx 1,500,000/= towards the cost of the **acoustic ceiling**.

The recent indicative estimate targeted for Ceiling works is Ugx 1.5 Billion as updated. The total collections received as at 1st August, 2022 is UGX **328,696,917/=** (Three hundred twenty eight million, six hundred ninety six thousand, nine hundred seventeen shillings.)

## THE PROVOST'S MESSAGE

### "THE POWER OF DIVINE RESTORATION AND RELEASE" (LEV 25:1-13)

God's presence brings full freedom and release from all chains and bondages of the devil. In this state Children of God are able to experience great liberty and excellence in every aspect of life. Something associated with this is 'Jubilee'.

Our main passage; Lev 25:1-13 brings out the development of Jubilee. In the seventh year the people were to rest and even have their land rest. In the 49th year they were to blow a trumpet to the Lord and on the fiftieth year celebrate Jubilee. All this shows God's mind towards our moment of reflection upon His godness linked to our full freedom and peace.

Scholars from *Theology of Work Project* Bible Commentary say these about Jubilee; "Leviticus 25 ordains a sabbath year, one in every seven (Lev. 25:1-7), and a jubilee year, one in every fifty (Lev. 25:8-17), to sanctify Israel's internal economy. In the sabbath year, each field was to lie fallow, which appears to be a sound agricultural practice. Every fiftieth year, all leased or mortgaged lands were to be returned to their original owners, and all slaves and bonded laborers were to be freed (Lev. 25:10)" This naturally posed difficulties in banking and land transactions, and special provisions were designed to ameliorate them (Lev. 25:15-16) "

Our topic today in relation to Jubilee is inclined towards Restoration and Release. Restoration implies that something or someone that was misplaced has been brought back to the right position. On the other hand release implies that someone or something held captive has been allowed the liberty to walk away from the person or something that was holding him or her stagnant in a certain place.

Looking at Leviticus 25:1-13, we get a picture of relief; God is with us even in the times of less work and reflection. Work is good and a blessing from God but during rest, reflection on God can help us so that we are not so much occupied by matters that hurt and divert us from the goodness of God.

In Luke 4:16(NIV)-Jesus carries on the same mind of Jubilee-Restoration and release in his mission as follows:-

*14 Jesus returned to Galilee in the power of the Spirit, and news about him spread through the whole countryside. 15 He was teaching in their synagogues, and everyone praised him.*

*16 He went to Nazareth, where he had been brought up, and on the Sabbath day he went into the synagogue, as was his custom. He stood up to read, 17 and the scroll of the prophet Isaiah was handed to him. Unrolling it, he found the place where it is written:*

*18 "The Spirit of the Lord is on me, because he has anointed me to proclaim good news to the poor. He has sent me to proclaim freedom for the prisoners and recovery of sight for the blind, to set the oppressed free, 19 to proclaim the year of the Lord's favor."*[f]

The good news is; restoration and release are available for you and I from God, through the Love of Jesus Christ. God is ready to bring back what we have lost and send us out to the world to reflect his goodness. God is ready to make us experience a season of Jubilee where too much labour, slavery and lack of belonging are dealt with in his eternal presence. Jesus can help us have peace and rest. Have we started the Journey to freedom by accepting Christ as our Lord and Saviour? Are we growing daily in Him? May God grant each of us the total restoration and release.
