THE PROVOST'S MESSAGE!

DO NOT LOVE THE WORLD 1 JOHN 2: 15-17

Jesus said, “*I do not ask that you take them out of the world, but that you keep them from the evil one.*” The evil one says what Jesus did wasn’t that impressive. He says the world and all that’s in it matters more. And as long as we’re in the world, we’re tempted to believe him. Love for the world crowds out love for the Father and at the same time, the love for the Father crowds out love for the world.

Verse 15 “Do not love the world or the things in the world. If anyone loves the world, the love of the Father is not in him.” What John says is not a suggestion. It’s a command. “Do not love the world.” God of the universe is speaking. With his authority as ruler and creator, in his sovereignty, he has the right to command us. John understood the world as the **entire system of rebellion against God and his rule**. F.F. Bruce says, “Worldliness...does not lie in things we do or in places we frequent; it lies in the **human heart**, in the set of human affections and attitudes.”

To John, worldliness is thinking the world is all that ultimately matters; placing it above the Father. What makes the world bad is not what is in it because it all came from God but **how we treat that which God created**. We cannot love the world and view it as ultimate and love the Father the same way. When we love the world, its pull is strong, and we are tempted. The world never stops making offers, and our flesh never stops window shopping. In verse 16, the world stands in opposition to the father “For all that is in the world; the desires of the flesh and the desires of the eyes and pride of life is not from the Father but is from the world.”

The mindset that says the world is ultimate originated from the world. When sin entered in, we **replaced God for God’s creation**. We distorted and twisted God’s good gifts into our ultimate hope. What we love is all about what we desire. The Greek word John uses is “epithumia” means “an intense desire for some particular thing.” It’s not simply a preference but a deep-desire for something desiring it above everything else.

Our call today reminds us about the topic for last week “In the world and not of the world”. Since **our citizenship is in heaven**, we need to Love God the father who created the Universe and Jesus Christ who died to set us free from the burden of sin. It is sin that draws us to the world to divert us from the creator who calls us to have fellowship with him (1 John 1:5-10). All we need is to return to Jesus who is our advocate and have a restored relationship with the father.
