THE PROVOST'S MESSAGE!

IN THE WORLD BUT NOT OF THE WORLD! (JOHN 17:6-19)

John 17:6-19 is a section of specific prayers that Jesus prayed for his original diciples. prior to this in verse 1-5 Jesus prays for glorification and after this in vs. 20-26 he prays for those who would later believe in Him through the disciples. Of great emphasis here is the idea"...in the world but not of this world..."

This phrase is very tricky for us but proper understanding of what it means can make us live a very productive christian life. John 17:6 reveal that disciples belong to God because of their obedience to His word. "I have revealed you[a] to those whom you gave me out of the world. They were yours; you gave them to me and they have obeyed your word. This then shows us that we do not belong to this world but belong to Christ through his word. Jesus then in John 15:6 asks God for preservation of this disciples while still in the world by the truth which is the word of God. "My prayer is not that you take them out of the world but that you protect them from the evil one. 16 They are not of the world, even as I am not of it. 17 Sanctify them by[d] the truth; your word is truth

God has placed us in this world to co exist with every other thing. The oxford dictionary defines the world as the earth, together with all of its countries and peoples. However it is important for us to take note that Jesus says that we are not of this world as he is not, a phrase implying that our origin and identity are in God the father, whom we can reconcile with through Christ himself-John 14:6. God has allowed us to live here in the world but He expects us not to pick anything negative or contrary to His word. This world has many negative satanic patterns. Bible scholars refer to these negative elements as world system opposed to everything that is Godly. They may range from pressure of unsaved people, traditions, culture, music and philosophies and ungodly laws.

The death of Jesus on the cross created an avenue for our salvation which ultimately leads to our victory over the world system of sin, defeat and the devil. Tempatations may come but God will always create a way out(1 Cor 10:13) if we yield to Him. (1 John 5:4). In the epistle 1 John 2:15-17 states "Do not love the world or anything in the world. If anyone loves the world, love for the Father[d] is not in them. 16 For everything in the world—the lust of the flesh, the lust of the eyes, and the pride of life—comes not from the Father but from the world. 17 The world and its desires pass away, but whoever does the will of God lives forever."

Last week we looked at being alive in Christ today this message continues to talk about the need for us to focus only on Jesus Christ, putting our attention on Christ and His heavenly glory. We are indeed heirs of eternal life with Christ. Our identity in christ gives us a belonging to a victorious family. Being in the world is not sin but diversion from Godily ways while in the world is sin. We therefore with the help of the Holy Spirit need to be very wise and careful in all aspects here as Children of God. At the same time we need to preach Christ in a loving righteous way to sinners.
