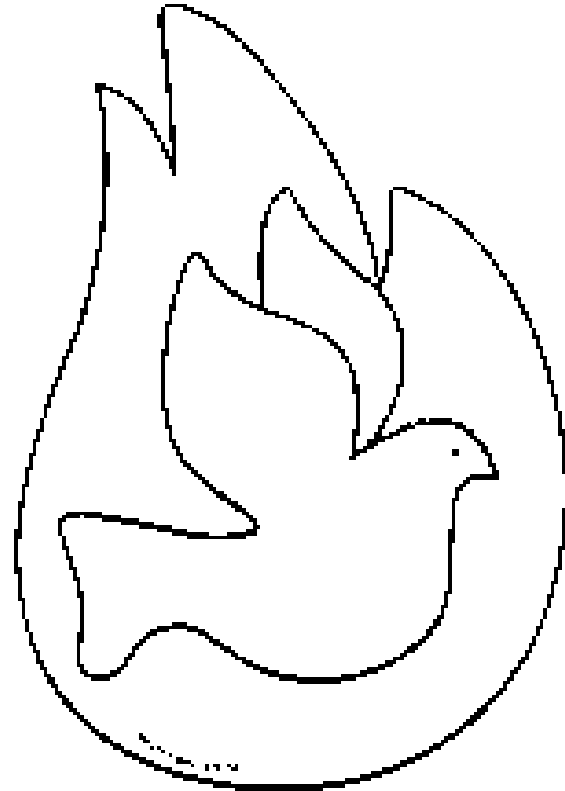
Point:

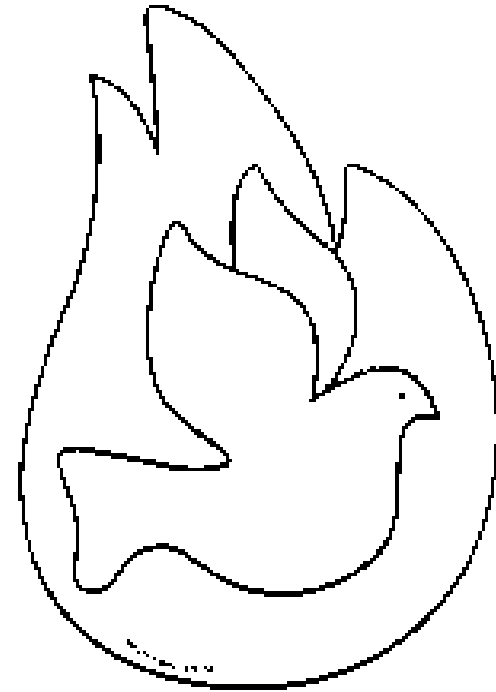

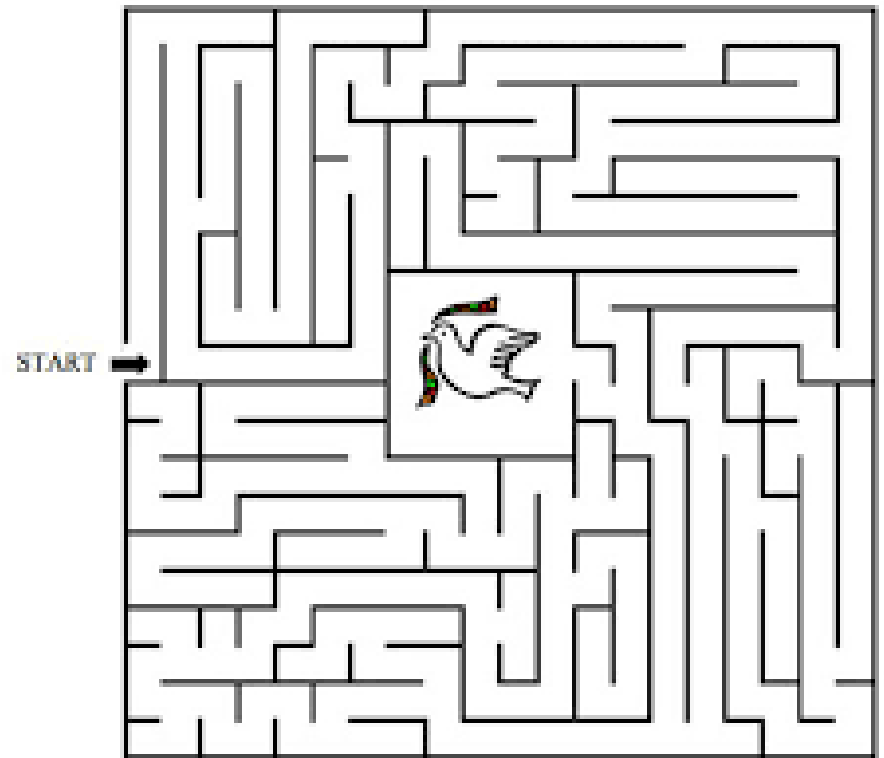

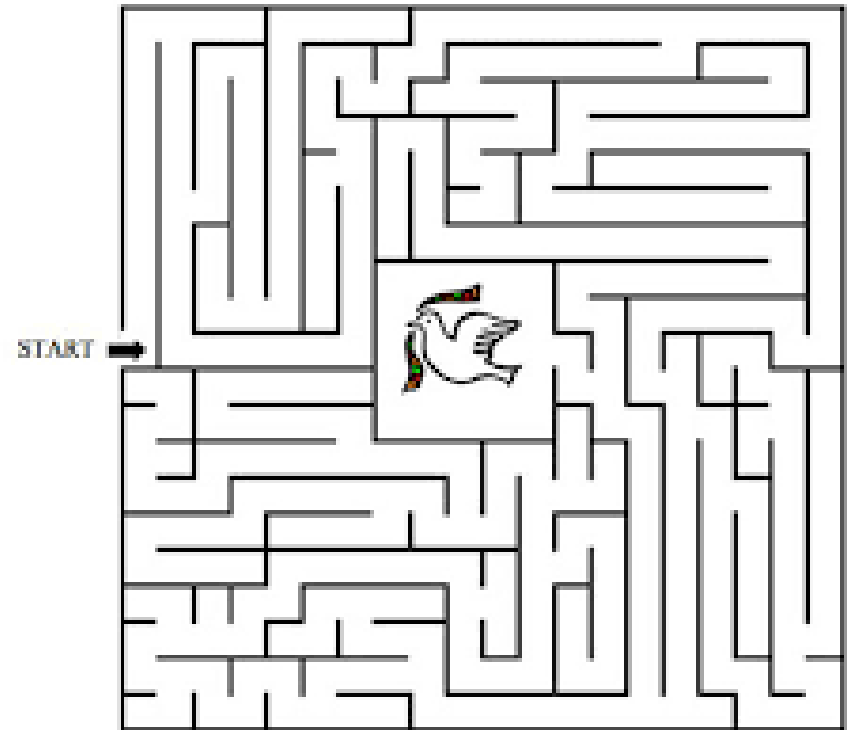
