First Read the full passage from Isaiah 11:1-9

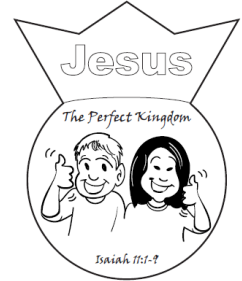

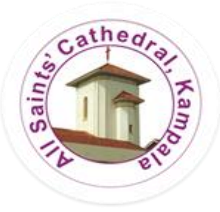

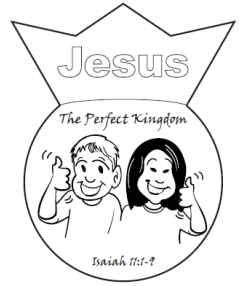
