

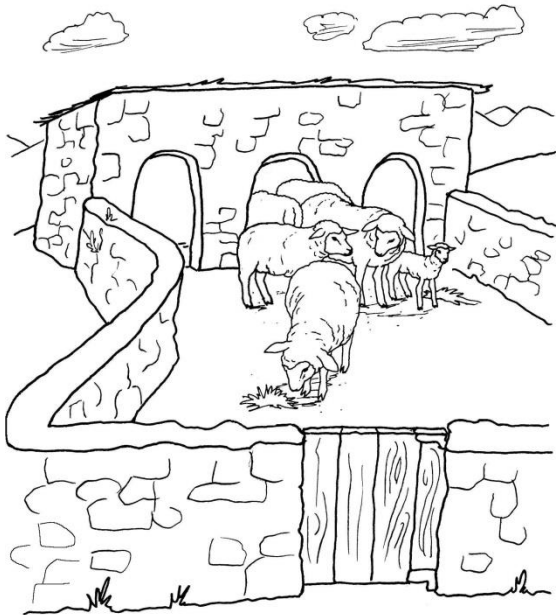

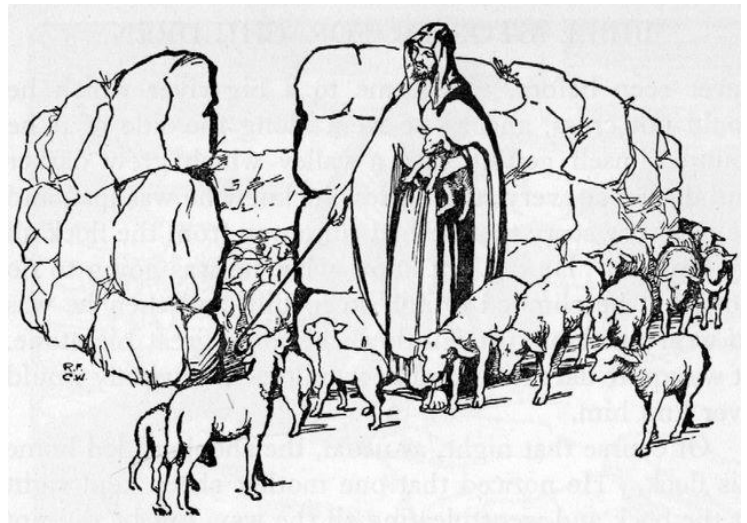

Jesus is the gate by which we should enter and the good shepherd whom we should follow to have life

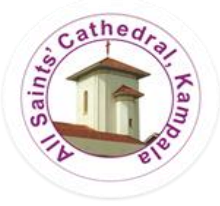

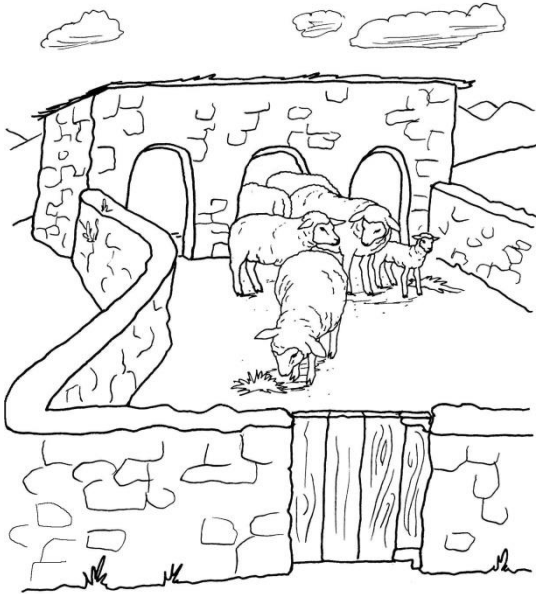

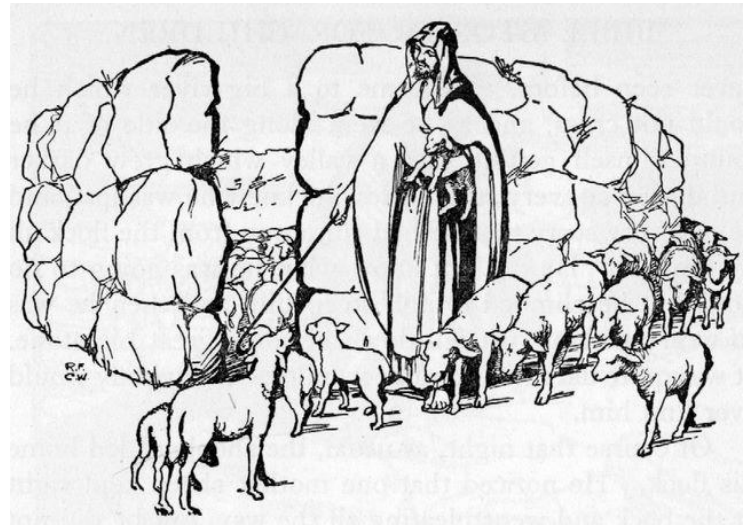

**Point:** Jesus is the gate by which we should enter and the good shepherd whom we should follow to have life



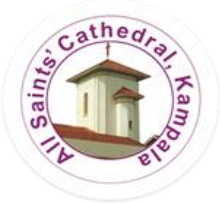
