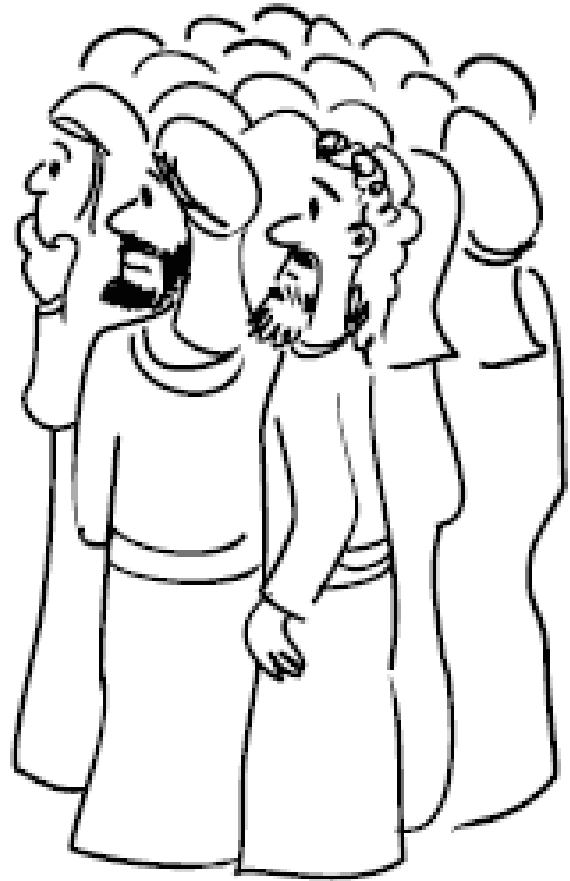

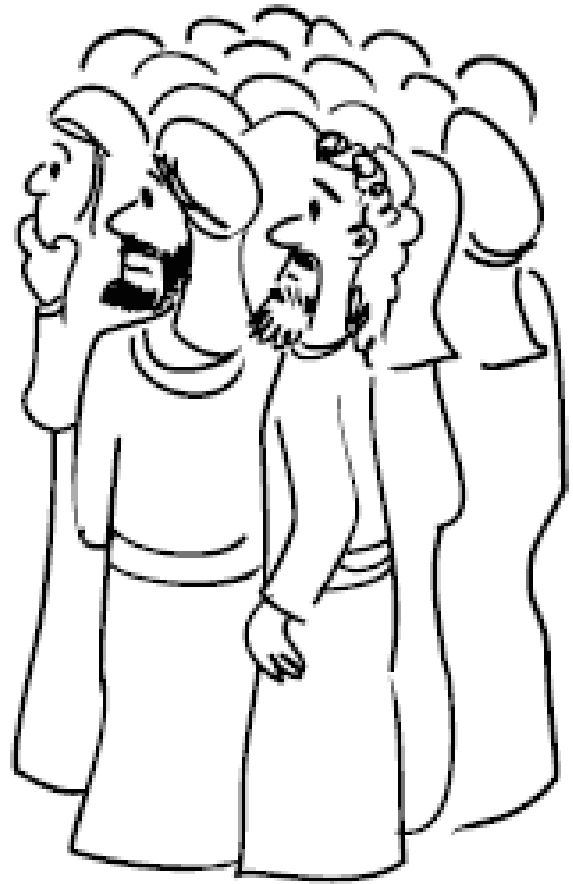

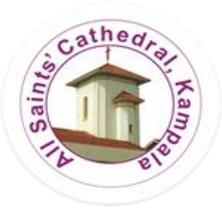

Point: Accepting the invitation of king Jesus requires lifelong repentance

Read the full story from Matthew 22:1-14

Jesus told a parable about the kingdom of heaven being like a king throwing a wedding banquet for his son and inviting guests. The invited guests refused to come and outsiders were invited. The outsiders



came but the person who was not dressed appropriately was thrown out.



Like the invitation to the wedding banquet which was rejected by the invited guests, God's chosen people (the Israelites/Jews) reject his invitation to his kingdom so the offer is opened to anyone. However, only a few people are willing to do what is needed to enter the kingdom of God; very few people are willing to repent and believe in Jesus.

God's chosen people (the Jews/Israelites) rejected Jesus to the extent of having him crucified. Even today, there are Jews who do not believe in Jesus.

The invitation to be part of God's kingdom was opened to anyone, but not many accept it. The invitation is accepted by repenting and believing in

Jesus. Accepting the invitation of King Jesus requires lifelong repentance.

Those who wish to be part of God's kingdom must not only show their willingness to have Jesus as their king (accepting the invitation) but also their willingness to live under his rule (dressing appropriately for the occasion), otherwise they will be thrown out like the man who went to the banquet without wedding clothes. Both things, **believing** (accepting the invitation) and **repenting** (dressing appropriately), **go together**. You cannot have one without the other.

In the same way, accepting the invitation of Jesus requires lifelong repentance. Those who say they are Christians but whose lives are not being changed will be excluded from heaven. One cannot say Jesus is their king and not let Jesus change any part of their life.

Think: Are you willing to continually repent and live as Jesus asks of you, to belong to the kingdom of God? Do you repent daily of your sin and try your best to live God's way?

Like the invitation to the wedding banquet which was rejected by the invited guests, God's chosen people (the Israelites/Jews) reject his invitation to his kingdom so the offer

is opened to anyone. However, only a few people are willing to do what is needed to enter the kingdom of God; very few people are willing to repent and believe in Jesus.

God's chosen people (the Jews/Israelites) rejected Jesus to the extent of having him crucified. Even today, there are Jews who do not believe in Jesus.

The invitation to be part of God's kingdom was opened to anyone, but not many accept it. The invitation is accepted by repenting and believing in Jesus. Accepting the invitation of King Jesus requires lifelong repentance.

Those who wish to be part of God's kingdom must not only show their willingness to have Jesus as their king (accepting the invitation) but also their willingness to live under his rule (dressing appropriately for the occasion), otherwise they will be thrown out like the man who went to the banquet without wedding clothes. Both things, **believing** (accepting the invitation) and **repenting** (dressing appropriately), **go together**. You cannot have one without the other.

In the same way, accepting the invitation of Jesus requires lifelong repentance. Those who say they are Christians but whose lives are not being changed will be excluded from heaven. One cannot say Jesus is their king and not let Jesus change any part of their life.
