Text Numbers 23:19

Introduction

In Genesis 15: we see Abram being assured not to be afraid, and why was he afraid

Because he was childless and aged . GOD assures him not to be afraid that God is his shield and his exceedingly great reward . God assures him against all his worries of his servant inheriting his estate.

Vs 6 Abraham believed God and it was accounted to him for righteousness.

Vs 13-21. Abram's descendants would go to captivity but come back and posses the very land.
