Definition of FAITH.

The best definition of this word is not found in the dictionary, it is in the Bible and well articulated in Hebrews 11:1;

"Now faith is the assurance of things hoped for, the conviction of things not seen."

PATIENCE:

Definition: The ability or willingness to suppress restlessness or annoyance when confronted with delay.

Synonyms include: Bearing, Calmness, composure, cool, diligence, endurance, forbearance, humility, serenity, submission, tolerance, yielding.

This takes a big portion of the fruit of the Spirit (*Galatians 5:22*) and there is a clear sense that achieving this attribute eliminates **corrupt** tendencies.
