So **the Word** was with God in the beginning and the **world** was made through Him. This **Word** is **Jesus**, **God the Son**.

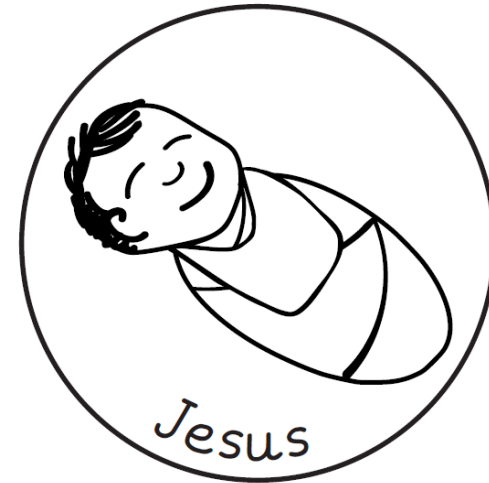
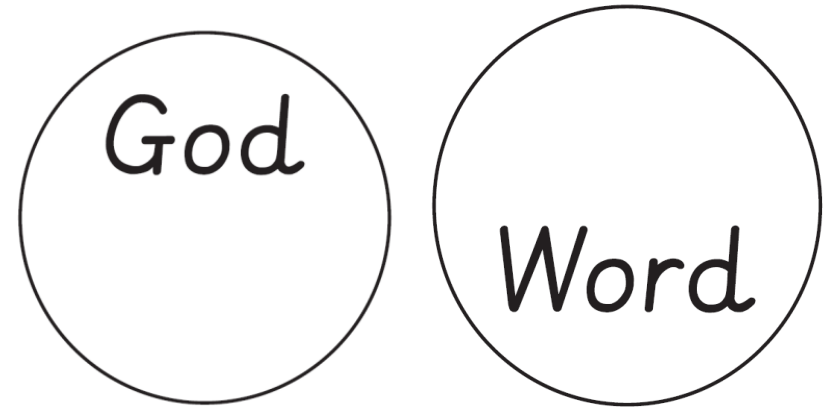


God the Son (Jesus) was with God the Father in the beginning; before he came to be born on earth.
