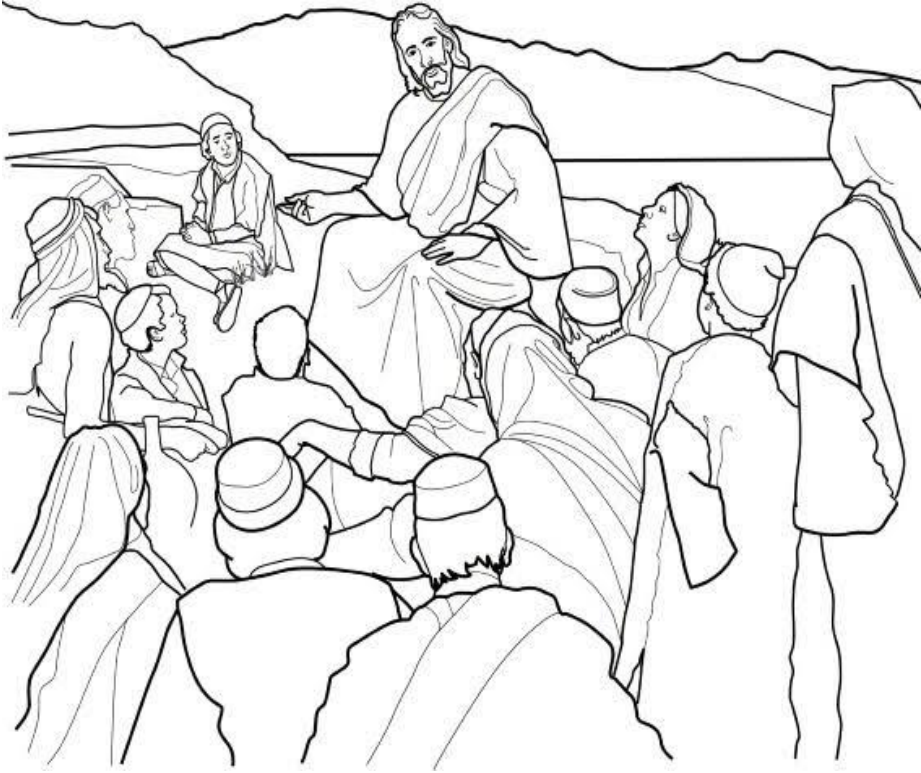

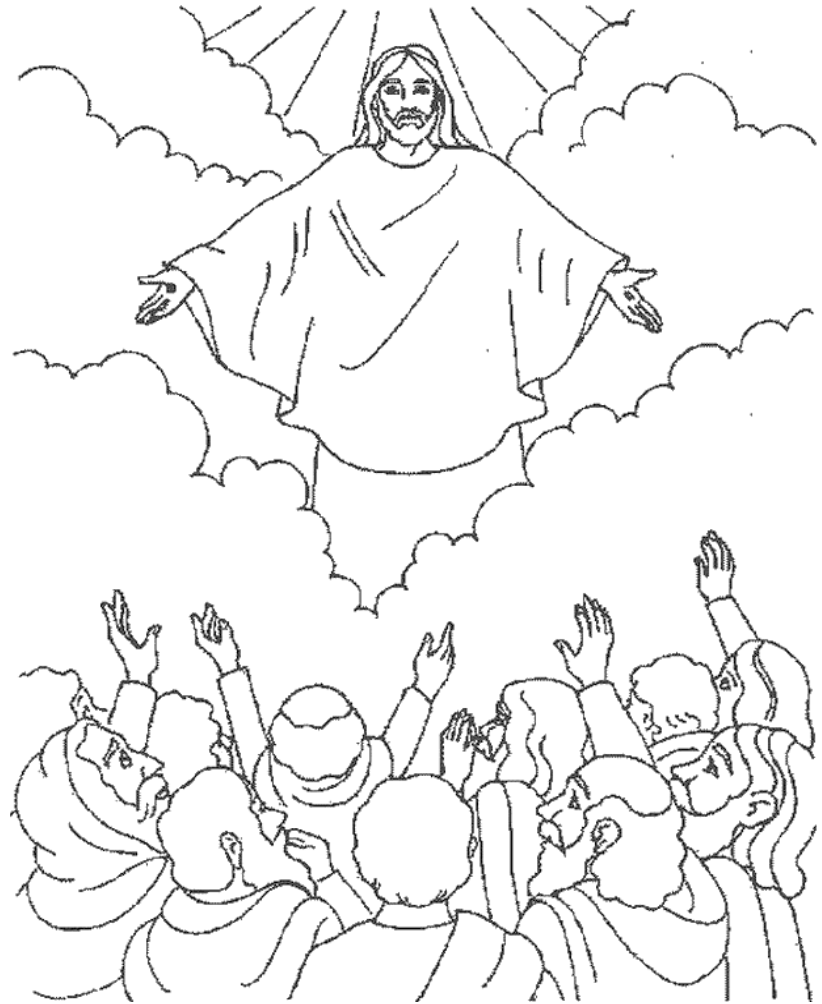
Reference: Acts 1:1-11
