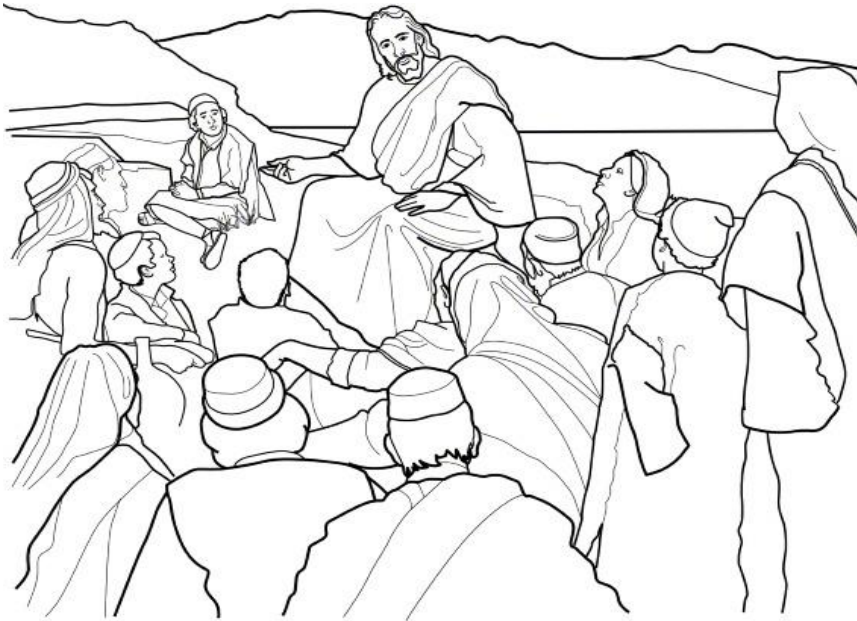

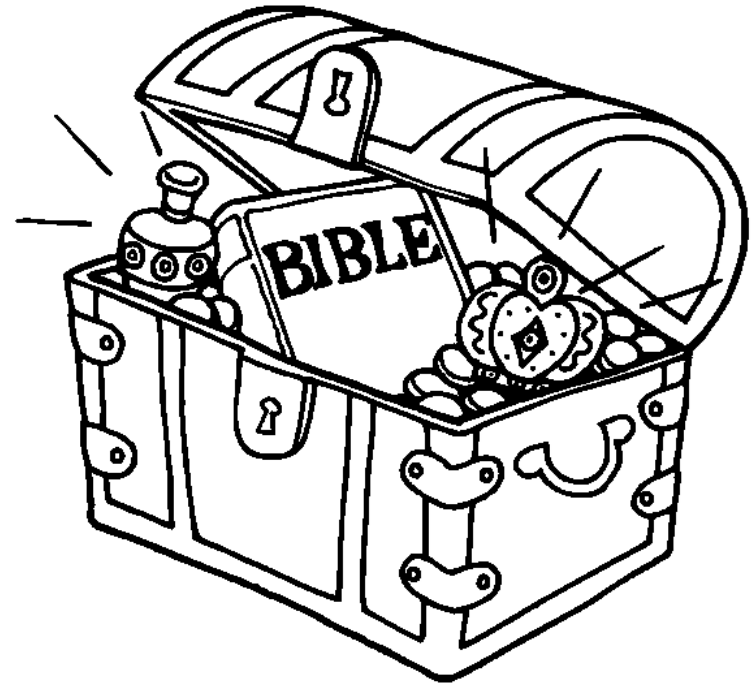
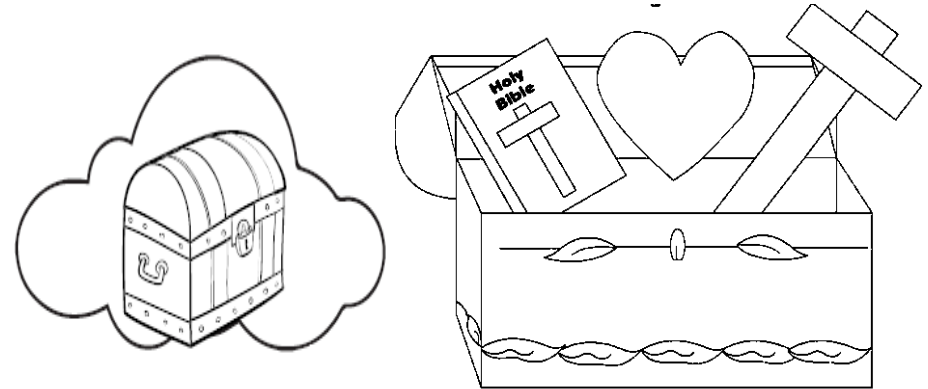
Lesson: TREASURE IN HEAVEN
