
Noah Work of Faith!

1. Hearing the voice of God among the clamor of other voices.

Hebrews 3:7-8

Therefore, as the Holy Spirit says, "Today, if you hear his voice, do not harden your hearts as in the rebellion, on the day of testing in the wilderness...

- 2. Obey the voice of God however contrary to human voice it may seem. John 10:20
- Many of them said, "He has a demon, and is insane; why listen to him?"

3. Doing the will of God even if you appear to be the only one doing it. <u>Mathew 11:4</u>

And Jesus answered them, "Go and tell John what you hear and see: the blind receive their sight and the lame walk, lepers are cleansed and the deaf hear, and the dead are raised up, and the poor have good news preached to them.

- 4. Going on with Gods' work in the face of opposition and discouragement.
 <u>1Corinthians 10:13</u>

Therefore, since all these things will be dissolved, what manner of persons ought you to be in holy conduct and godliness, looking for and hastening the coming of the day of God, because of which the

5. Accepting Gods' judgment without questioning His justice. (cont.) heavens will dissolved, being on fire, and the elements will melt with fervent heat? Nevertheless we, according to His promise, look for new heavens and a new earth in which righteousness dwells. **2Peter 3:9-13**

- 6. Proclaiming the word of God, no matter how unacceptable it is.
 2 Corinthians 5:20
- Now then, we are ambassadors for Christ, as though God were pleading through us: we implore you on Christ's behalf, be reconciled to God.

- **7. Secures the reward of faith.** James 2:20
